You are a practical, detail-focused technician who thrives in live performance environments. With hands-on experience in technical theatre—whether lighting, sound, or stage—you're confident working under pressure and adapting quickly to changing show needs. You take pride in making sure every setup is safe, efficient, and show-ready. Comfortable jumping into different roles as required, you work well with both visiting crews and venue teams. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the technical team by performing day-to-day duties within the Devonshire Quarter.
- To assist with the safe and efficient running of all get-ins, fit ups and get-outs in conjunction with the full-time staff.
- Work with the technical team to ensure that the correct equipment is prepared and supplied for visiting and in house productions, as required.

- To set-up and operate all technical equipment including follow spots, lighting and sound consoles and flies as and when required.
- To ensure the correct and safe usage of all equipment at all times and to report any defects or faults that occur.
- Provide first-line maintenance support and repairs on the theatre's equipment.
- To ensure good housekeeping is maintained at all times.
- Ensuring that all Health & Safety legislation relating to the department is observed and be aware of all requirements and safety procedures in place.
- Any other duties as directed by the Technical Manager or appointed representative.

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- **Attendance and punctuality**
The work is time critical, so it is important to be reliable and arrive on time ready to start work,
- **Task efficiency**
Complete assigned tasks promptly and correctly. Be able to follow cue sheets or running orders without repeated reminders.
- **Flexibility and adaptability**
Willingness to do a variety of tasks (eg scene changes, follow spot operation, conference setups) and adapt to last minute changes.
- **Health & Safety Compliance**
Comply with all health and safety regulations, procedures and practises and report any issues to senior staff.
