KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Complete all planned preventative and reactive maintenance tasks.
- Ensure effective induction and supervision of contractors on site, in accordance with agreed venue processes and safety system at work procedures.
- Complete building service checks and compliance audits on appropriate digital systems.
- Be a designated keyholder for the venue.
- Fault find on all mechanical and electrical systems and escalate to specialist contractors and service providers where required.
- Complete monthly meter readings and report as appropriate.
- Take ownership of all regular checks regarding water safety and life safety systems.
- Provide support to the Facilities Manager and Building Team, covering periods of absence where necessary.
- Maintenance support for live events as and when required.
- Maintain Health and Safety and Fire Safety procedures.

Attend any required training as identified by the management team.
