ABOUT THIS ROLE

Working with the technical department to support productions staging and seating requirements. To support the successful delivery of live events by providing hands-on assistance with the setup, operation, and breakdown of performances, productions, and venue activities. This role is critical in ensuring smooth transitions, safe working practices, and exceptional audience and artist experiences.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support the technical department & touring productions during load in, set up, soundchecks, shows and load outs
- Assist with loading and unloading equipment from trucks, lorries and vans(e.g. lighting, sound, staging, backline, crew catering).
- Set up and strike staging, seating, drapes, signage, and barriers.
- Run cables, rig lighting or sound gear under supervision.
- Follow all health and safety procedures, including safe manual handling.
- Wear appropriate PPE and maintain a clean, hazard-free working environment.
- Act as a fire marshal if trained and assigned.
- Maintain venue cleanliness during and after events.
- Attend briefings and debriefs and carry out tasks as delegated by the duty technician or touring management
- Always represent the venue's values and professionalism.

ABOUT YOU

We're looking for a punctual, reliable person with experience crewing on stages for live events. Needs to be able to communicate well and work well with large teams. Able to work flexible hours, mornings, evenings and weekends. Someone who is passionate about live events and the music industry.

Essential Skills

- Safe and efficient loading/unloading of vehicles
- Manual handling skills (lifting, carrying, pushing cases and equipment)
- Familiarity with basic stage setup (risers, backline, mic stands, cabling)
- Competence in cable management (running and taping cables neatly and safely)
- Handling backline gear safely and respectfully (amps, drums, keys, etc.)
- Understanding of stage plots
- Awareness of show flow and stage changeovers
- Understanding of safe working zones and clearances (e.g. around flying trusses or active load-ins)
- Listening and following instructions from stage/production managers and duty technicians
- Working effectively as part of a team in high-pressure environments
- Maintaining professionalism when working around artists and tour crew
- Awareness of basic venue safety procedures (e.g. fire exits, evacuation routes)
- Ability to use PPE appropriately (gloves, steel-toe boots, hi-vis when needed)
- Awareness of noise levels and use of hearing protection

- Previous experience with touring productions or festivals
