- Maintain high standards of backstage presentation, cleanliness, and organisation.
- Support emergency and evacuation procedures in line with venue policies and procedures.
- Assist the Events Manager in promoting a safe working environment and ensuring the health and safety of staff, artists, and touring productions.
- Help deliver outstanding customer service and a welcoming, professional experience for all backstage visitors.

- Actively promote and uphold the organisation's commitment to equality, diversity, and inclusion.
- Take responsibility for your own health and safety, and contribute to a positive safety culture across the venue.
- Carry out any other reasonable duties in line with your skills, experience, and the needs of the organisation.
